Mayor's Message



NEW CONSTRUCTION

The Borough of Stratford is once again pleased to announce an enormous improvement to a vacant and dilapidated commercial site located at 72 Berlin Road.

At the council meeting held on Tuesday June 11, 2024, the governing body ratified a 30-year pilot program with RSG Stratford Urban Renewal LLC paving the way for a 17 million dollar new construction project. Financially, the new construction will benefit the taxpayers as follows:

In 2023, the borough realized a mere \$4,645.00 in property taxes from the site.

Under our negotiated 30-year pilot agreement, the borough will now receive <u>unto itself</u> a minimum of <u>\$186,000.00 annually</u> in direct payment in lieu of property taxes.

To further enrich the deal for our taxpayers, the governing body negotiated to receive unto itself, <u>\$267,000.00</u> in non-residential development fees as a form of a direct payment from the developer. As a result of the new construction, <u>\$60,000.00</u> in local permitting fees shall also be assessed.

Aside from the financial windfall, we are pleased to rid Stratford of the junk yard that has blighted Stratford for far too long.
