Dear Neighbors,

As this winter storm begins to pass, I wanted to take a moment to share a quick update while hoping everyone has stayed safe.

At this time, approximately 500 homes and two public schools in Stratford remain without power. Chief Morello has notified Atlantic City Electric of all known outages, and I have also been in contact with the utility company. Unfortunately, they do not currently have a timeline for restoration and are advising residents to plan accordingly for the possibility of prolonged outages.

To help residents during the outage and blizzard conditions, we will be opening the Community Center today (2/23) from 4:00–6:00pm for anyone who needs to charge their phones or electronics. Please bring your own chargers and power strips. Please note that parking is limited (9 spaces at the Community Center and 10 at Borough Hall), this is for Stratford residents only, and the maximum building occupancy is limited to 125 people.

Our police, fire, and Department of Public Works crews have been working around the clock throughout the storm to keep our community safe, clear roadways, and respond to downed trees and other hazards.

We ask residents to continue avoiding hazards such as downed trees, limbs, and wires throughout town. Our Department of Public Works crews are continuing to plow roads and safely remove debris as conditions allow.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation, and for looking out for one another during this storm.
