

SPECIAL NEEDS REGISTRY



The Stratford Police Department in partnership with the Camden County Prosecutor's Office, would like to get the word out to our residents regarding our new & updated Special Needs Registry. The registry is a direct-feed to the Stratford Police Department. Registration information will be made available to our police officers and shared with **Fire** and **EMS** officials in the event there is an emergency involving the registrant, or their place of residence.

The registry will provide police and first responders with emergency contact information, photographs, detailed physical descriptions, known routines, favorite attractions, or special needs of an individual.

Examples of special needs include, but are not limited to:

- **Concerning Mental Health Issues**
- **Mobility Issues (wheelchairs, power chairs, walkers)**
- **Dementia or Alzheimer's Disease**
- **Cognitive Impairments**
- **Autism**
- **Oxygen Dependency**
- **Hearing, Vision, or Speech Deficits**
- **Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder**
- **Dialysis Dependent**
- **Paralysis /Stroke Patients**
- **Developmental/ Intellectual Disabilities**
