DUMPSTER PERMIT – UPDATE

It seems there is some confusion related to the borough's dumpster permit requirement.

Whenever a homeowner has a need to obtain a dumpster for excessive trash, debris, remodeling waste, etc. at <u>their home</u>, they should stop in or call the borough office and obtain an application to fill out, and then return the permit application. Thereafter, the application is reviewed, and if approved the resident pays the \$25 fee.

When a dumpster is authorized to be placed in a public street it must have proper reflective devices and in no way impede or obstruct traffic or site views.

If the dumpster does not meet the requirements for street placement, it must be off the street and in the driveway or front lawn.

A dumpster can remain in place for <u>only a 30 day period</u>. For the health and safety of our community, under <u>no</u> circumstances will a dumpster be permitted to be placed on a Borough owned street for the purpose of collecting trash for hire, commercial purposes, profit or to be transported to Stratford from other communities, who may not permit dumpsters at all.
