

**RESOLUTION 25: 195**

**BOROUGH OF STRATFORD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW  
JERSEY AUTHORIZING CANCELLATION OF PROPERTY TAXES DUE  
TO TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN TAX EXEMPT STATUS**

**WHEREAS**, an application has been received from Emily J. Balog, Property Owner and resident of 101 Harvard Ave., Block 30 Lot 13, for an exemption from the payment of property taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Property Owner. suffers from a service-connected disability and has been declared 100% permanently and totally disabled by the U.S. Veterans Administration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tax Assessor has determined that the Property Owner has submitted the required documentation and is entitled to an exemption from property taxes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by Mayor and Council of the Borough of Stratford, that the property known as 101 Harvard Ave. shall be placed on the Exempt Property List effective 10/22/25.

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED** that the Borough Tax Collector is authorized to cancel property taxes billed for the 4th Quarter 2025 in the amount of \$1,542.80 and refund said amount to the property owner's mortgage company, Corelogic.
