

RESOLUTION #104-2026

BOROUGH OF STRATFORD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR IT/COMPUTER SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Borough of Stratford has determined that ongoing professional IT/Computer services are necessary to ensure secure, reliable, and compliant operation of municipal computer systems, network infrastructure, cybersecurity protections, and user support; and

WHEREAS, the Borough solicited quotes in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible and responsive quote has been determined to be: Bellia Technology with a total contract price of \$1000.00 per month, as set forth in their bid proposal for the Borough Hall office only; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that awarding this contract is in the best interest of the Borough, ensuring continuity of operations, data security, and reliable technical support for municipal departments; and

WHEREAS that the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough has certified the availability of funds in the amount of \$12,000 between the following three budget line appropriations: 6-01-20-100-000-208; 6-07-55-502-000-208; and T-03-00-615-000-000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Stratford, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that:

1. The contract for IT/Computer Services is hereby awarded to Bellia Technologies, the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, for the total amount of \$12,000.00 per year at \$1000.00 per month for services related to the Borough Hall office.
2. The Mayor and/or Business Administrator/Municipal Clerk is authorized to execute the contract and any related documents on behalf of the Borough.
3. The award shall be published in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.
