

**RESOLUTION #105-2026**

**BOROUGH OF STRATFORD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN  
AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HI-NELLA BOROUGH SEWER  
SERVICE AGREEMENT TO INCLUDE NEWLY CREATED LOT AT 35 PAWNEE  
ROAD AS AN APPROVED SEWER CONNECTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Hi-Nella and the Stratford Sewerage Authority are parties to a Sewer Service Agreement dated September 1, 1993, governing Hi-Nella's use of the Stratford sewer collection system; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 1 of said Agreement permits a specified number of domestic consumer units, as listed on Schedule "A," to connect to and flow through the Stratford collection system; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 4 of the Agreement requires that no additional connections be made to the Authority's sewer collection system unless approved by the Authority and, if required, the Camden County Municipal Utilities Authority and/or the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Hi-Nella has completed a subdivision creating a new residential lot known as 35 Pawnee Road, which requires sewer service and must be formally added as a domestic consumer unit under the Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the addition of this newly created lot constitutes an increase to the number of domestic consumer units allocated to Hi-Nella under Schedule "A," and therefore requires formal amendment and authorization; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Hi-Nella seeks to request and authorize the Stratford Sewerage Authority to approve the connection and incorporate the newly created lot into the Agreement's domestic consumer unit count.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Hi-Nella, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that:

1. The Borough hereby authorizes and requests an amendment to the 1993 Sewer Service Agreement to add the newly created lot known as 35 Pawnee Road as an approved domestic consumer unit permitted to connect to the Stratford Sewerage Authority collection system.
2. The Borough Clerk is authorized and directed to transmit certified copies of this Resolution, together with all supporting subdivision documentation, to the Stratford Sewerage Authority for review and approval pursuant to Section 4 of the Agreement.
3. Upon approval by the Stratford Sewerage Authority, Schedule "A" shall be amended to reflect the additional domestic consumer unit.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
