ADOPTING PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURES FOR THE 2026 GOVERNING BODY**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by Mayor and Council of the Borough of Stratford, that the book on parliamentary procedure entitled "Robert's Rules of Order", Current Edition, shall govern all meetings of this Council.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that "Good and Welfare" shall be the last order of business taken up by Council at each meeting for the year of 2026, unless Council should designate otherwise. Also, before Committee Reports, the meeting shall be opened to the public to comment on matters pertaining to the items on the agenda of the meeting.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that members of the public recognized to speak shall have a maximum of five (5) minutes to address Council per person, per meeting, during each opportunity for Public Comment listed on a given agenda.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that these rules are subject to change at the discretion of the Governing Body.
