ACKNOWLEDGING FIRM NAME CHANGE AND APPROVING ENGAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Stratford previously appointed Scott Barron, CPA, RMA, as the Registered Municipal Accountant and engagement Partner pursuant to the proposal submitted under the name Bowman & Company LLP under Resolution # 03-2026; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized to execute the engagement contract with PKF O'Connor Davies LLP, naming Scott Barron, CPA, RMA, as Partner, consistent with the terms of the proposal previously submitted and approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other provisions of the original appointment remain in full force and effect.
