**RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF STRATFORD  
AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A NON-FAIR AND OPEN CONTRACT FOR BOND  
COUNSEL SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Stratford is in need of professional Bond Counsel services related to the Borough's finance matters; and

**WHEREAS**, Jeffrey D. Winitzky, Esquire of Parker McCay provides professional services related to capital bonding services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough has the need to acquire the professional services from Jeffrey D. Winitzky to be provided hereunder as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 or 20.5; and

**WHEREAS**, it is expected that the value of the services will not exceed \$17,500 in one (1) year; and

**WHEREAS**, Jeffrey D. Winitzky has certified that it did not make a reportable campaign contribution during the one-year preceding the award of the Contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.8; and

**WHEREAS**, Jeffrey D. Winitzky has completed a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that it has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Borough of Stratford in the previous one (1) year; and



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** The Mayor, Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Borough Bond Counsel Agreement with Jeffrey D. Winitzky for the year 2026.
