

RESOLUTION #76-2026

**BOROUGH OF STRATFORD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL
AMBULANCE PURCHASE & SERVICE AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Boroughs of Hi Nella, Laurel Springs, Lawnside, Magnolia, Somerdale, and Stratford have each identified a need for a new ambulance to ensure the continued health, safety, and welfare of their respective residents; and

WHEREAS, the Magnolia Ambulance Corps provides emergency medical services to all six municipalities, and it is both practical and financially beneficial for the municipalities to jointly participate in the purchase of a new ambulance based on the proration of services provided; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Magnolia will serve as the lead agency for the procurement of the ambulance pursuant to State Contract through Sourcewell #122123-RVG-1 for AEV: Emergency Vehicle Excellence, through their dealer VCI, located at 43 Jefferson Avenue, Berlin, NJ 08009; and

WHEREAS, the participating municipalities have negotiated and agreed upon the terms of an Interlocal Ambulance Purchase & Service Agreement, which includes cost-sharing, ownership, housing of the vehicle, scheduling of use, and ongoing maintenance responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, Stratford's prorated capital contribution toward the total purchase price of \$150,000.00 is \$40,409.00, to be issued directly to the Borough of Magnolia prior to delivery of the ambulance, as set forth in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., authorizes municipalities to enter into shared service agreements for the provision of governmental services, including emergency medical services and capital equipment purchases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Stratford, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Interlocal Ambulance Purchase & Service Agreement between the Boroughs of Hi Nella, Laurel Springs, Lawnside, Magnolia, Somerdale, and Stratford, in the form attached hereto, and to take all necessary actions to effectuate the Borough's participation therein.
