**BOROUGH OF STRATFORD, CAMDEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE
BOROUGH OF PITMAN FOR STREET SWEEPING SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Stratford has a need for municipal street sweeping services and the transport of collected sweeping debris, and Stratford does not possess a street sweeper apparatus; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Pitman possesses a street sweeping apparatus, containers, and swap loaders and is willing to provide sweeping services, equipment, and operators to Stratford pursuant to the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, *N.J.S.A.* 40A:65-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Shared Services Agreement provides that Pitman will sweep Stratford's public roads three (3) times per year, provide debris transport, and perform related services, with Stratford responsible for labor costs, disposal costs, and any repairs beyond normal wear and tear; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Stratford finds that entering into this Shared Services Agreement is in the best interest of the Borough and promotes efficient and cost-effective municipal operations.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Stratford, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that the Shared Services Agreement between the Borough of Stratford and the Borough of Pitman for street sweeping and related public works services is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Borough of Stratford.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a fully executed copy of the Agreement and this Resolution shall be transmitted to the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs in accordance with law.
