

RESOLUTION #118-2026

**BOROUGH OF STRATFORD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN
AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENTING AUTHORITY TO APPOINT A POLICE
OFFICER FROM THE REGULAR REEMPLOYMENT LIST PURSUANT TO
N.J.S 4A:4-7.10 & N.J.S. 11A:4-6**

WHEREAS, the Mayor & Borough Council of the Borough of Stratford finds that for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Stratford Borough that the activation of a police regular reemployment list is desirable to seek trained and qualified former police officers to be considered for reemployment with the Borough of Stratford Police Department; and

WHEREAS, The New Jersey Civil Service Commission allows for the appointment under certain criteria, which shall include former permanent employees who resigned in good standing and whose reemployment is certified by the appointing authority as in the best interest of the service. The name of any such employee shall not remain on a reemployment list for more than three years from the date of resignation, unless otherwise extended pursuant to [N.J.S.11A:4-6](#); and

WHEREAS, the Police Officer Title Certified List # OL170879 had previously been certified in 2017 resulting in the appointment of Police Officers who now meet the criteria set forth under N.J.A.C 11A:4-9 of the New Jersey Civil Service Commission Acts; and

WHEREAS, Dominic V. Romeo appears on the canvassed *Certified List* #OL260815 dated 7/23/26 having resigned in good standing from the Stratford Police Department on or about 3/09/2025 and having served as a FT Civil Service Police Officer since 9/27/2017, TO WIT: 7 years, 5 months, 10 days.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor & Borough Council of the Borough of Stratford to appoint, effective 9/01/2026, with a subsequent report date, from the regular reemployment list, Dominic V. Romeo, to become reemployed as a Police Officer at the salary, scale, and contractual step where he had terminated employment in 2025;\$109,702.32 for the remainder of 2026 and to advance in accordance with the commensurate step raises, for his time and grade, in accordance with the agreement Between the Borough and P.B.A. Local 30.
