

RESOLUTION #122-2026

**BOROUGH OF STRATFORD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN
TO REAPPOINT A MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE UNDER A
SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF OAKLYN**

WHEREAS, the Municipal Court of Stratford Borough is a shared service entity pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., and the Municipal Court Judge is appointed jointly by the governing bodies of the participating municipalities;

WHEREAS, the current Municipal Court Judge, William Stopper, appointment expires August 31, 2026;

WHEREAS, the Service Agreement, memorialized by the passage of Borough of Stratford Resolution #25:64, and provides for reappointment by resolution of the governing body;

WHEREAS, the municipalities participating in the shared service arrangement have agreed to continue the arrangement and to reappoint the current judge for the term set forth in the Service Agreement;

WHEREAS, the reappointment is in the best interest of the municipalities and the public, ensuring continuity of court operations and judicial service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Stratford hereby reappoints William Stopper, JMC as Municipal Court Judge for the term of three (3) years, commencing on September 1, 2026 and ending on September 1, 2029, subject to the terms and conditions of the Service Agreement;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution and the Service Agreement shall be forwarded to the Municipal Clerk of each participating municipality and to the Camden County Superior Court as required by law.
