

RESOLUTION #126-2026

**BOROUGH OF STRATFORD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN
AUTHORIZING 50% CANCELLATION OF PROPERTY TAXES DUE
TO TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN TAX EXEMPT STATUS**

WHEREAS, an application has been received from Adam Demesko, 50% Property Owner and resident of 18 Longwood Drive, Block 98 Lot 12, for a 50% exemption from the payment of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Property Owner. suffers from a service-connected disability and has been declared 100% permanently and totally disabled by the U.S. Veterans Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has determined that the Property Owner has submitted the required documentation and is entitled to a 50% exemption from property taxes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Mayor and Council of the Borough of Stratford, that the property known as 18 Longwood Drive shall be placed on the 50% Exempt Property List effective 6/29/26.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough Tax Collector is authorized to cancel property taxes billed for the 2nd Quarter 2026 in the amount of \$26.03, the 3rd Quarter 2026 in the amount of \$1,275.58 and refund said amount to the property owner's mortgage company Cotality.

BE IT RESOLVED the Tax Collector is also authorized to cancel 50% of all future taxes billed.
